

**ADDENDUM TO EQUI-VENTURE EQUESTRIAN CENTRE BOARDING**  
**CONTRACT**

1) Each boarder is responsible for providing the following stall accessories: 1 flat back water bucket (preferably 2), 1 removable feed tub, 1 heated water bucket with covered heating element for winter use, fan for summer use, 1 heavy duty extension cord for heated bucket or fan, double ended snaps and screw eyes to hang buckets, large salt block to put on floor under feed tub, halter and lead rope. If your horse requires a hay net/rack, this is your responsibility as well. Optional accessories like floor mats, toys, cross ties, stall guards, blanket bar, etc. are okay with stable manager's approval. INITIAL\_\_\_\_\_

2) All reimbursements and open accounts for showing, lessons, farrier, vet, fees, etc. paid by and due to Hugo and/or Ruth Helmholz will be paid within three days of service or notice date. If not paid within 3 days then a late fee of \$5 for each \$50 paid by Hugo and/or Ruth Helmholz will be added. INITIAL\_\_\_\_\_

3) Worming schedule is at least every 8 weeks. All horses will be wormed on the same date with the same spectrum wormer. There will be no exceptions to this unless directed by your vet. Please check the message board for worming date, type wormer and cost. If stable supplies the wormer, ALL WORMER COSTS PLUS \$1 MUST BE PAID IN ADVANCE WITH THAT MONTH'S BOARD. Should the boarder choose to supply the wormer, he/she agrees to have the same spectrum wormer given to the stable manager by the worming date or to show proof that he/she wormed with the same spectrum wormer on the worming date. If the wormer isn't at the stable or no proof is shown by the due date, the horse will stay in until wormed. If owner does not worm the horse by the third day, then the horse will be wormed by the stable manager and all expenses will be due immediately. A penalty of \$10 will then be due along with the wormer fee. INITIAL\_\_\_\_\_

4) It is mandatory that all horses have a yearly vet exam, Coggins and vaccinations as recommended by their vet. If the owner wants to administer his/her own vaccinations, he/she can do so with proof and receipts given to stable manager for the horse's health record. However, an exam by a vet and a Coggins are still required. If this is not done, then EQUI-VENTURE EQUESTRIAN CENTRE will have this done at the owner's expense by the farm's vet if the owner's vet choice is not available. A message will be posted when the vet is coming out for the farm. Please sign up for work needed if you would like to split the farm call. If stable personnel handle or hold your horse for any vet work, there will be a \$\_\_\_\_\_ per \_\_\_\_\_ minute Handling Fee per horse. You may schedule your own vet appointment. 5) It is mandatory that all horses have a yearly dental exam. This may be done by the owner's vet or equine dentist. A receipt or proof must be given to the stable manager for the horse's health record. If this is not done, then EQUI-VENTURE EQUESTRIAN CENTRE will have this done at the owner's expense by the farm's vet or dentist if the owner's vet or dentist is not available. A message will be posted when the dentist is coming out to treat the farm's horses. You may sign up if you would like to have any work done or schedule your own vet/dentist appointment. If stable personnel handle or hold your horse, there will be a \$\_\_\_\_\_ per \_\_\_\_\_ minute Handling Fee per horse. INITIAL\_\_\_\_\_

6) It is a requirement of this stable that all horses have regular farrier care. Please let the stable manager know when and what was done to your horse's hooves so it can be put into your horse's health record. Upon monthly examination of each horse's record, if there is no record of an appointment or if the horse is lame or showing farrier work is needed, a call will be made to the owner with the expectation that the horse will be promptly taken care of. If the horse's hooves are not taken care of in a time frame that the stable manager feels is acceptable, then EQUI-VENTURE EQUESTRIAN CENTRE reserves the right to have this done at the owner's expense by the farm farrier if the owner's farrier is not available or does not show up. Should stable personnel notice a lost or loose shoe, the owner will be notified. A message will be posted when the farrier is coming out to take care of the farm's horses. If stable personnel handle or hold your horse for the farrier, there will be a \$\_\_\_\_\_ per \_\_\_\_\_ minute Handling Fee. You may sign up if you would like any work done when the sign up sheet is posted, or automatically be put on the list when your horse is due, or schedule your own farrier appointment.
