EVEN THOUGH THIS PARTICIPANT AND/OR RIDER IS A GUEST AND IS NOT RIDING THIS STABLE'S HORSE OR PARTICIPATING IN THIS STABLE'S ACTIVITY OR EVENT, ALL TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH IN THE LIABILITY RELEASE(S) ARE IN EFFECT AND BINDING.

INHERENT RISKS AND NATURE OF HORSE WARNING Horseback riding and horse driving is classified as a **RUGGED ADVENTURE RECREATIONAL SPORT ACTIVITY**, and there are numerous obvious and non-obvious inherent risks always present in such activity despite all safety precautions. No horse is a completely safe horse. Horses are 5 to 15 times larger, 20 to 40 times more powerful, and 3 to 4 times faster than a human. If a rider falls from a horse to the ground it will generally be at a distance of and/or from 3 ½ to 5 ½ feet, and the impact may result in injury and/or death to the rider. Horseback riding/horse driving is the only sport where one much smaller, weaker predator animal, the human, tries to control and become one unit of movement with another much larger, stronger prey animal, the horse, with each having a limited understanding of the other. If a horse is frightened or provoked it may divert from its training and act according to its natural survival instincts which may include, but are not limited to: stopping short, changing direction or speed at will, shifting its weight from side to side, bucking, rearing, biting, kicking or running from danger.

LIABILITY RELEASE: In consideration of this stable allowing me, as a guest of _____, to visit THIS STABLE and/or participate in the riding and/or handling of _____'s horse(s), under the terms set forth in the Liability Release For Individuals, I, the rider, and the parent or legal guardian thereof if a minor, do agree to hold harmless and release THIS STABLE, its owners, managers, instructors, trainers, guides, wranglers, agents, employees, officers, members, premises owners, students, volunteers and affiliated organizations from legal liability due to THIS STABLE'S ordinary negligence; and I do further agree that except in the event of THIS STABLE'S gross and willful negligence, I shall bring no claims, demands, actions and causes of action, and/or litigation, against THIS STABLE and ITS ASSOCIATES as stated above in this clause, for any economic or non-economic losses due to bodily injury, death, property damage or loss sustained by me and/or my minor child or legal ward in relation to the premises and operations of THIS STABLE, TO INCLUDE WHILE RIDING, HANDLING, OR OTHERWISE BEING NEAR HORSES BY OR IN THE CARE, CUSTODY AND CONTROL OF THIS STABLE. I feel that the possible benefits to myself, my minor child or legal ward of participation in equine activities or being around horse on or near THIS STABLE'S property are greater than the risks assumed.
