### SOME GENERAL INFORMATION

- Shows ARE held in our indoor arena during inclement weather. **Call or check our website / Facebook page for information** related to **possible** postponements for extreme weather (ie. storms, wind chill / frostbite warnings, temperatures below 30, heat index / high humidity warnings or temperatures above 90). **Postponements are posted by 8 AM the morning of the show.**
- Show committee reserves the right to combine, divide or cancel any classes. Announcements the day of the show take precedence over the Show Bill. Classes may NOT run in order because different arenas may be used. Lunch and other breaks will be announced.
- Exhibitors may ride English or Western. Proper attire is not required. However, safe, clean schooling attire is required. **ASTM equestrian helmets are required by ALL when mounted. Safety vests are approved.**
- Horses and ponies must be neat and clean. Protective boots, gear and tack are encouraged.
- Rulings are done according to the 4-H and/or AHSA.
- Negative Coggins required for off-farm horses or ponies.
- All participants, volunteers and spectators will be required to sign a Liability Release.
- No alcohol, illegal drugs or disruptive behavior allowed. Smoking is restricted to the parking lot or trailer site only and all butts must be picked up.
- Please keep your dog home.
- Food will be available. Plus a 50/50 drawing, raffle, and gift items. All proceeds go to our horse rescue.
- Please bring your own lawn chairs and canopies.
- Please check our Information Wall in the stable entrance for farm rules, upcoming events and additional information.+

**ACTIVE EVEC MEMBERS:** \$4.00 per class pre-registration (24 Hrs Before) or \$6.00 per class day of show  
plus \$3.00 per exhibitor for Insurance Fees

OR

Play All Day for \$40.00 pre-registration ONLY (24 Hrs Before) plus \$3.00 per exhibitor for Insurance Fees.  
Fees do not include show prep, horse/pony rental, tack rental or coaching fees.

**REGULAR EVEC MEMBERS:** \$5.00 per class pre-registration (24 Hrs Before) or \$7.00 per class day of show  
plus \$3.00 per exhibitor for Insurance Fees

OR

Play All Day for \$50.00 pre-registration ONLY (24 Hrs Before) plus \$3.00 per exhibitor for Insurance Fees.  
Fees do not include show prep, horse/pony rental, tack rental or coaching fees.

**NON-EVEC MEMBERS:** Entry fees are the same as Regular EVEC Members. Insurance Fees are \$10.00 per exhibitor.

**NOTE:** Class Fees are Non-Refundable unless a class is scratched by the exhibitor two classes ahead of time. No refunds for Play All Day exhibitors unless more than 8 classes are cancelled by the show committee. Any other fees are not refundable.

# DIVISIONS

**\*No division awards or points will be given for open classes.**

**PEE WEE** - Reserved only for Pony Pals (riders ages 4-6 on leadline with optional sidewalkers) that cannot trot or jog. **All classes will done at the walk only. NOTE: These exhibitors may not enter W/T or OPEN classes.**

**W/T** - Pony Pals (riders ages 4 - 6 on leadline without sidewalkers or may have assistance on unattached leadline) **AND** Young Riders (riders ages 6 -10 years on leadline or may have assistance on unattached leadline)

**NOTE: Trotting and/or jogging may / will be done. NO Cantering OR Loping permitted. These exhibitors may not enter OPEN classes.**

**JR** - Junior Riders (riders ages 16 years old & under)

**SR** - Senior Riders (riders ages 17 and over) Unless the show committee combines classes, SR exhibitors may be over 40, but they may not cross enter into AR classes.

**AR** - Adult Riders (riders ages 40 and over) Unless the show committee combines classes, AR exhibitors may not cross enter into SR classes.

**IN-HAND** - Handler of any age exhibits with the horse in-hand. May cross enter into JR, SR, and AR classes. No PEE WEE or W/T exhibitors.
