- Drive pick up truck to do farm work or do errands (Must be over 21 and approved)
 - Drive a subcompact farm tractor to do farm work ie: bush hog, spread manure, drag arenas, snow removal, etc. (Must be over 21, approved and have experience especially on uneven and hilly terrain)
 - Maintain farm equipment and tools ie: farm tractor and attachments, lawn mowers, weed eaters, etc.
 - Help with beginner lessons and Pony Pals (training provided)
 - Side walking or lead lining (training provided)
 - Ring crew at lessons and clinics (training provided)
 - Grooming lesson and rescued horses (training provided)
 - Grooming at trail rides, stable events and/or horse shows (training provided)
 - Help with rehabilitating rescued horses (training provided)
 - Exercise horses (if your riding skills & knowledge are approved)
 - Feeding, haying and watering horses (training provided)
 - Stable cleaning and stall mucking (training provided)
 - Keep grooming supplies and/or kits clean and organized (training provided)
 - Tack and equipment cleaning and conditioning (training provided)
 - Facility maintenance & improvements (carpentry, electrical, plumbing and/or mechanical)
 - Grounds keeping (grass cutting, weed eating, hand weeding, picking up rocks & manure in grass, refilling driveway patches, etc)
 - Building and painting jumps and trail class obstacles
 - Building and/or maintaining Cross Country jumps and X-treme Cowboy Trail courses
 - Trail clearing and maintenance
 - Putting up fence lines
 - Helping to maintain pastures and turn out areas (checking fence lines, picking up rocks & debris, weed eating, manure removal)
 - Become a trail guide (if your riding skills & knowledge are approved, training will be provided)
 - Work on the fundraisers: EVEC horse shows, stable activities, trail rides, parties, etc. for various positions ie: event secretary, treasurer, food booth operator, cook, event directors /operators, ring crew, decorating, etc. (training provided)
 - Office help ie: advertising, legal services, accounting services, phone calls, lesson and/or course preparation, printing services, office supplies, computer services, etc.
