FEE SCHEDULE

Effective January 1, 2012

A Note to Our Clients: We have applied for our non-profit organization status. All fees collected from our programs and activities go to help our horse rescue efforts, take care of the horses, maintain the facilities and help keep our horsemanship programs and stable activities going. During these hard economic times, we will also try to help anyone in need to pursue their horsemanship goals and equi-ventures. We ask our members for a year round commitment to our programs to help us maintain our budget. Thank you.

TRAINING

TRAINING: Board plus -

\$15/session w/ Apprentice Trainer

\$18.75/session w/ Assistant Trainer

\$20/session w/ Head Trainer

BOARDING

FULL BOARD: \$375 per month The horse has a box stall and the fee includes hay, feed and bedding according to the allotments listed on the following page. Seasonal turnout - the horse may stay out 24-7 weather permitting.

PASTURE BOARD (no grain provided): \$210 per month The horse is kept out in the pasture and the fee includes hay according to the allotments listed on the following page. EVEC will feed any owner provided feed / supplements for an additional fee.

PASTURE BOARD (with grain provided): \$280 per month The horse is kept out in the pasture and the fee includes hay and grain according to the allotments listed on the following page.

SELF CARE BOARD: \$250 per month for box stall rental and the fee includes hay as needed in the turnout areas according to the allotments listed on the following page. Owner's horse is only allowed in turnout area for 12 hours each day. Owner must provide labor and supply feed, hay for the stall, bedding (sawdust), cleaning implements etc. and storage for such items. Owner must follow the stable's routine and rules. EVEC will feed any owner provided feed / supplements for an additional fee. Additional fees apply for extra services provided.

PARTIAL BOARD: Fees depend on care needed plus self care. EVEC will feed any owner provided feed / supplements for an additional fee. Additional fees apply for extra services provided.

LAY UP: Fees depend on care needed plus full board.

LAY OVER: \$18 per day subject to availability.

BOARDING FEES INCLUDE:

- Daily health checks
- Applications of fly spray / topical medications (owner provided)
- Blanket checks and changes (owner provides blankets)
- Bi-monthly de-worming (additional charge for dewormers unless owner provides)
- Record keeping
- Complete use of facility and tack room
- **GRAIN:**
 - **Full Board or Pasture Board (w/ grain) only:** Horses are fed a 10% protein sweet feed or local whole oats provided by EVEC and fed twice daily along with any owner provided supplements. **Total allotted amount of \$40 per month.**
- **HAY:** Hay or hay products fed twice daily if the horse is stalled as part of the stable's routine schedule. **As needed:** round bales will be used in pastures or turnout areas or square bale hay may be fed twice daily. The cost of round bales (or square bales if used in the pasture / turnout area) will be divided by the number of horses in that pasture or turnout area. **There is a total allotted amount of \$90 per month per horse for any round bale, square bale or hay cube / pellet usage.**
- Fresh water and salt blocks in fields
- Stall cleaned up to 6 days per week and bedding provided (for Full boarders). **Total allotted amount of \$30 per month for bulk sawdust.**
- Turnout / bring in as weather permits (for Full Boarders)
- Surcharges will be added for additional grain, hay or bedding or if costs are higher than what is allowed by our budget.
- Other fees apply for any Additional Services provided at the end of this fee schedule.
- There are no credits for any unused allotments of bedding, hay and / or grain.
- **OPTIONAL LESSONS:**
 - **DISCOUNTED MONTHLY PRE-PAID LESSON PACKAGE:** Boarder will receive 1 weekly scheduled lesson on his / her horse / pony per month with our in-stable instructors. **Boarder receives \$5 discount per lesson for using his / her own horse / pony AND another 25% discount off regular lesson fees. (Comes to \$18.75 per group lesson in a 4 week month). This also gives the boarder Regular Student status for additional discounts on most of our stable activities.** Lessons are on a Use It or Lose It basis (none will be carried over).
 - **DISCOUNTED PAY WEEKLY LESSONS:** Established boarders in good standing may schedule weekly lessons on a pay weekly basis. **NOTE:** The boarder will be expected to pay for a lesson each week, whether they take it or not. These lessons will follow our policies as far as cancellations or missed appointments. **Boarder receives \$5 discount per lesson for using his / her own horse AND another 15% discount off regular lesson fees. (Comes to \$21.25 per group lesson). Boarder must pay the Saturday before the lesson.**
 - **DISCOUNTED DROP-IN LESSONS:** Boarder can "drop-in" a scheduled lesson on his / her horse with our in-stable instructors (with instructor approval). **Boarder receives \$5 discount per lesson for using his / her own horse AND another 5% discount off regular lesson fees. (Comes to \$23.75 per group lesson). Boarder must pay prior to lesson.**
 - **There are no insurance / registration fees as long as boarder uses his / her own horse / pony.**
 - **NOTE:** There is no discount for any lessons with any of our outside instructors.
- **BAD WEATHER MODE:** During severe or extreme weather; some pasture boarded horses may be brought inside and kept in the indoor arena or in a temporary stall. This is determined by the number of horses in a field that will have access to the run-in sheds. This determination is based on pecking order issues, age and health of the horses and may change at any time. The stable management determines which horses come in; NOT boarders. **If your horse is on the list to come in; there will be additional charges for hay, bedding, etc. Please let the stable manager know ahead of time if that is a problem.**

GENERAL INFORMATION

PARTICIPANT STATUS: In order to receive any applicable discounts for stable activities or other programs, an EVEC member is described in the following:

- **Regular Student:** Participant that takes one Pre-paid Package lesson per week.
- **Active Student:** Participant that takes two Pre-paid Package lessons per week **OR** takes one Pre-paid Package lesson **and** other Pre-paid session activity(ies) that equal to the amount of a second lesson.
- **Volunteer:** Volunteers are just that; volunteers. They work (usually under 10 hours a week) and they do not get reimbursed (or receive discounts) for their time.
- **Working Student or Working Parent:** An active student and / or the parent of an active student that has a set weekly 'time' schedule doing stable chores (under 24 hours) at the stable in order to receive Working Student discounts or coupons towards additional lessons, programs and / or activities. There is a signed agreement.
- **Staff Member:** An EVEC member that actually has an assigned position(s) at the stable and works 24 hours or more at the stable for wages, reduced or free board / lease option, reduced or free programs / activities OR any combination thereof. There is a signed agreement.
- **EVEC Team Member:** An EVEC student that has paid a membership to belong to the team and stays active with the team: attends meetings, takes appropriate lessons or clinics, attends team activities, etc.

SESSIONS: Our sessions run for two months. The start date is the 1st of one month and ends on the last day of the following month. There are usually eight and nine weeks in a session. In some cases, there may be seven or ten weeks.

ENROLLMENT / REGISTRATION FEES: To keep our programs affordable and to help pay for the insurance related costs for each client, there will a **\$25 enrollment / registration fee for each student / participant and is due every session. However, for clients that take 2 or more private lessons per week with our in-stable instructors, these fees will only be charged every 6 months.**

PRE-PAID PROGRAM PACKAGES: These are offered in sessions and receive a **10% discount**. Participants pay for the number of appointments scheduled for each month in the session. All appointments are on a "Use It or Lose It" basis and no appointments will be carried over. Proper cancellation notice according to our Program Policies is required or participants will be charged for any missed appointments. Allowed make-ups must be done within the current session or they will be forfeited. **NOTE: There are NO discounts offered for appointments with our outside instructors, trainers and / or coaches.**

PAY WEEKLY or PAY MONTHLY LESSONS: These options are **only offered to established EVEC clients** that are in good standing or those that have been accepted for **financial assistance**. **No discounts are offered.** A non-refundable **deposit equal to one appointment fee will be required for each session**. This deposit can be carried over to the next session if there were no missed appointments.

DUE DATE FOR PAYMENTS: To simplify our bookkeeping and to help maintain a budget:

- **All package payments are due the Saturday before the first of the month that the session starts.**
- **All weekly payments are due the Saturday before the next unpaid appointment.**
- **All monthly payments are due the Saturday before the first of the month.**
- **All payments for clinics, workshops, stable activities, etc. are due the Saturday before the activity date unless stated otherwise. No reservations for activities will be accepted without payment.**
- **Drop-in or last minute additional appointments must be paid upon arrival at the stable.**
- **Open accounts for additional services, additional feed / hay / bedding, farrier / vet services, transportation, showing / clinic / schooling expenses, etc. are due upon receipt.**
- **A \$10 late fee will be applied for payments that are not received when due.**

BILLING: We send statements via email.

ADDITIONAL DISCOUNTS:

- We allow a \$5 discount for each additional **pre-paid** lesson per week from the same student or additional immediate family member.
- We allow \$5 off if a participant uses his / her own or leased horse / pony.
- Other discounts may be offered as financial assistance (if available).
- There are NO discounts for any appointments with our outside instructors, trainers and / or coaches.

PRORATED PACKAGES: A new participant may join our programs at any time during the month, whether at the beginning, midway or at the end. His / her first session will consist of the weekly appointments remaining in the month that the participant signs up and the following month. The lesson payments (including the registration / insurance fees) will be prorated accordingly to the number of weeks remaining in that session:

- **Less than 8 weeks but 5 or more weeks remaining:** A courtesy discount of 5% will be applied to the package.
- **3 or 4 weeks remaining:** The remaining appointments in that month will be charged at the weekly rate and paid for at the time of registration. The following month will actually start the 2 month session. The new session payment will be due the Saturday before the first of the following month. (The participant has the option to add these weeks to the next session to receive 10% off at the time of registration).
- **1 or 2 weeks remaining:** The participant pre-pays for the 1 or 2 remaining weeks in the current month along with the next session. The entire package receives the 10% discount.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE: We believe that by helping others, we (essentially the horses) will, in turn, be helped if the need arises. Great things can be accomplished if everyone pitches in (even if just a little) and helps each other. **We will offer assistance to any existing EVEC member or new participant that is in need, as long as our budgeting allows.** However, the reduction of fees does take away from the money we have for the rescue and care of the horses. Therefore, we ask everyone to be **completely honest about their financial situation.** We also ask for a **long term commitment to stay in our programs, volunteer and to help with donations whenever possible.** We use sliding scales based on the family's income and needs, as well as other considerations. Assistance may be available for more than one program at a time (ex: lessons and camp). Assistance is also available for adults. **We offer the following types of confidential financial assistance:**

- Additional Discounts through Specials or from work opportunities on the farm
- Temporary Assistance for 1-2 months
- Short Term Assistance for 3-6 months
- Long Term Assistance for 6-12 months
- On-going Assistance for low income families

NOTE: Please let the Horsemanship Director / Stable Manger know of your needs as soon as possible. This will help us our budget. Please see our website for our additional information and the forms.

DONATIONS: **If a member is in the financial position to help; sponsorships or donations of feed, hay and bedding are always needed and greatly appreciated.** We ask everyone to **consider a regular donation of 2 bags of feed each month or money towards hay. Monetary donations are needed as well, to help with farrier, vet, supplies and other expenses incurred by our horse rescue.** Every dollar helps! **Please think about a sponsorship.** Information about sponsorships is enclosed near the end of this document. If each member pitches in \$20 per month (that's just \$5 per week), the horses' needs would be so much easier to meet. Perhaps 2-3 members can do a sponsorship together. **If you cannot afford to donate, then please consider volunteering!**

FEES for LESSONS & SCHOOLING

RIDING LESSONS: All ages, even adults, are welcomed! Offering beginner through advanced levels. English, Western, Dressage, Combined Training, Trail Riding and Hunter/Jumper lessons available. All appointments include time to follow our Lesson Format, (please refer to our Lesson webpage).

PONY PALS: \$30 per student

For ages 4 – 6 in groups of 3 – 6 riders 45 minutes (maximum 20 minutes ride time)

A parent / guardian is required to assist with grooming, tacking and untacking of the horse and sidewalking (if needed). This fee allows for a stable appointed lead liner. If a parent/guardian is unable to help with sidewalking (if needed); there will be an additional \$5 charge per rider.

SPECIALTY or YOUNG RIDER GROUP RIDING / UNMOUNTED LESSONS: \$30 per student

For groups of 3 to 6 riders 60 minutes (maximum 30 minutes ride time)

Specialty lessons include lessons:

- taught for specialty disciplines – please refer to our Horsemanship Classes
- whenever the arena needs to be ‘closed’
- when a leadliner is or may be needed

REGULAR GROUP RIDING / UNMOUNTED LESSONS: \$30 per student

For groups of 3 to 6 riders 90 minutes (maximum 45 minutes ride time)

SEMI-PRIVATE RIDING / UNMOUNTED LESSONS: \$40 per student

For 2 riders 60 minutes (maximum 30 minutes ride time)

PRIVATE RIDING / UNMOUNTED LESSONS: \$55 & up

Fee depends on type of lesson and /or instructor

For 1 rider 60 minutes (maximum 30 minutes ride time)

SPECIALTY or OUTSIDE INSTRUCTOR’S RIDING / UNMOUNTED LESSONS: \$50 & up

Fee depends on type of lesson, number of students and /or instructor’s fee

Horse fee and ring fee will also apply

No discounts are offered

PRACTICE RIDES: \$20 per session for Regular EVEC student

\$15 per session for Active EVEC student

- Practice sessions should be scheduled 48 hours in advance, although, sometimes can be approved the same day.
- There are no guarantees on the availability of a particular school horse.
- Practice sessions are on a Pay-As-You-Go basis and payment is expected upon your arrival.

SCHOOL MASTER USE: \$20 per lesson

EQUI-BASICS COURSE: For safety concerns, equine health issues and educational purposes; this course is required for ALL new participants and volunteers.

- If one is an existing member that has not previously taken this course, To be excluded from this policy: a new member that is an experienced horse person, must be able to demonstrate required skills & procedures and/or pass our Equi-Basics exam.
- he/she must also pass the examination and/or demonstrate the required skills & procedures.
- Equi-Basics may be started at the same time a new member or a beginner starts our programs and/or lessons. One does not have to wait to start riding lessons!
- Classes are offered 2-3 times per week, as the need arises.
- Students may take more than one class per week.
- The information presented with this course is basic. More detailed courses are available in our Equi-Studies programs.
- There are 12 classes within the course. A new, experienced student / member may only have to take a portion of the course if the results of his / her exams dictates so. but
- If a class participant needs additional time to master a particular skill, additional practice time can be arranged for a small fee of \$3 for each session.

FEES

\$90 for the entire course or \$7.50 per needed class.

Payments may be split into 3 installments of \$30. Each installment is due no later the Saturday before the next unpaid appointment.

If the course is paid for in total at the time of registration of a lesson program, there will be a \$30 discount.

There is no charge for the course if needed for training purposes for a volunteer, working student or staff member.

TRAILER –IN SCHOOLING FEES: All persons visiting and using our facility must observe our farm rules. Reservations required. Negative Coggins required. Liability releases required.

Trailer–In Fee: \$5/trailer

Arena Use: \$15/hour per horse

Cross Country Use: \$20/hour per horse

Discount rates available for groups or if a rider has more than 2 horses.

FEES for ADDITIONAL RIDING OPPORTUNITES

BIRTHDAY & ENTERTAINMENT PARTIES: Start at \$15/guest for groups up to 10 and \$12/guest for groups over 10 for up to two hours of entertainment. Please call for details.

PONY RIDES: \$10 per child. 10 minutes in the roundpen or indoor arena. Sixty pound weight restriction of child applies.

GUIDED TRAIL RIDES: \$35 & up per hour per person. Reservations and pre-approval required. Age, weight, and riding ability restrictions will apply. Discount rates are available for Trail Riding Lesson students. Call for details.

PONY CLUB and 4-H PROJECTS: Call for information, requirements and availability.

THEREPEUTIC RIDING: Call for information and availability.

FIELD TRIPS TO OUR STABLE: Group Package rates start out at \$7 per person. Call for information.

SCOUT BADGE PROGRAM AT OUR STABLE: Group Package rates start out at \$10 per person. Call for information.

HORSE & TACK SALES

ADOPTIONS

\$150 minimum Adoption / Donation Fee even if horse/pony is listed as FREE.

Applications must be approved.

Horse / pony can be resold after a set time period to another home approved by EVEC.

Humane Society has right to inspect at any time.

EVEC always has right (with no refund of adoption fees) to get animal back should the horse no longer be wanted or if EVEC finds that the horse is not being properly cared for.

Payment arrangements are available for most adoptions.

Trial periods are allowed with signed contract.

EQUI-LEASING & EQUI-SHARING OPTIONS for EVEC HORSES / PONIES

***Lessee must also take at least one paid lesson each week with all Lease Options. Lessee receives \$5 discount per lesson for using his / her leased horse. This lesson fee is NOT included in the following rates.**

NOTE: There is no discount for any lessons with any of our outside instructors.

***Equi-Lessees must provide their own tack and equipment.**

***Additional fees for any approved school master use.**

**FULL EQUI-LEASE: STALL KEPT: \$400 per month
PASTURE KEPT: \$300 per month**

- Leases run for three months at a time.
- Lessee is the exclusive rider / handler.
- Allows for five 90-minute sessions per week or approved usage for shows, club activities or trail riding. One weekly paid lesson is to be used as one of sessions. This lesson fee is NOT included in the lease fee.
- The horse / pony is to have 2 work days off per week.
- Lessee pays for all vet, equine dentist, farrier and all other leased horse / pony expenses.

**HALF EQUI-LEASE: STALL KEPT: \$225 per month
PASTURE KEPT: \$175 per month**

- Leases run for three months at a time.
- Lessee shares the horse / pony with another lessee(s). Selected days / times will be scheduled by both parties with the stable manager.
- If there is no other lessee, the owner / stable manager acts as the other half lessee.
- Allows for four 90-minute sessions per week or approved usage for shows, club activities or trail riding. One weekly paid lesson is to be used as one of sessions. This lesson fee is NOT included in the lease fee.
- The horse / pony is to have 2 work days off per week.
- Each lessee pays for half of all vet, equine dentist, farrier and all other leased horse/pony expenses.

PARTIAL EQUI-LEASE: STALL KEPT: \$150 per month
PASTURE KEPT: \$100 per month

- Leases run for three months at a time.
- Lessee shares the horse / pony with up to 4 other lessee(s). Selected days / times will be scheduled by all parties with the stable manager.
- If there are not 4 lessees, the owner / stable manager acts as the other lessees.
- Allows for three 90-minute sessions /week or approved usage for shows, club activities or trail riding. One weekly paid lesson is to be used as one of sessions. This lesson fee is NOT included in the lease fee.
- The horse / pony is to have 2 work days off per week.
- Each lessee pays for 1/4th of all vet, equine dentist, farrier and all other leased horse/pony expenses.

FREE EQUI-LEASE: Regular boarding fees apply.

No lease fee because there is no significant lost income from free leasing the horse/pony.

- Leases run indefinitely until either party terminates. If lessee no longer wants the horse / pony, the animal is returned to the owner.
- Lessee is the exclusive rider / handler and is the 'acting' owner.
- One weekly paid lesson is required for the free lease of an EVEC horse/pony.
- The horse / pony is to have 2 work days off per week.
- Lessee pays for all vet, equine dentist, farrier and all other leased horse / pony expenses.

EQUI-SHARE: This is a great way to get into a regular riding schedule without being committed to a 3 month lease. (Additional fees will be charged for any approved School Master use.)

3 days a week @ \$50/week

1-2 days a week @ \$20/session

- Paid monthly in advance the Saturday before the first of the month.
- The school horses on the Equi-Share List are available for the participant to choose from.
- Participant must have instructor/stable manager approval for the selected horse/pony. This is based on the participant's ability to properly ride / handle the desired horse / pony.
- Allows up to the number of reserved 60-minute sessions / week or approved usage for in-stable shows, in-stable club activities or trail riding on the farm - **in addition to** weekly paid lesson.
- All ride times must be scheduled in advance and are on a 'Use It or Lose It' basis.
- Horse / pony may have several riders / handlers.
- The horse / pony must have at least 2 work days off per week.
- No vet, equine dentist, farrier or any other equi-leased horse / pony expenses.
- Includes tack and equipment rental.

EQUI- PROJECT PROGRAM

A Hands-On Sponsorship

This is a unique hands-on sponsorship opportunity at EVEC. We like our rescue horses, (as well as some of our other horses) to receive additional attention from an individual that will help the horse / pony to develop a bond. Unlike our other sponsorships, this program allows for the sponsor to actively work with and help rehabilitate the horse / pony. These individuals are registered and qualified students that are CHOSEN by the staff. **NOTE: These horses / ponies ARE NOT leased to the assigned individual.** The individual must keep in mind that **these horses / ponies are used by other people or students, and that they may be leased, sold or adopted at any time. Project horses and sessions must be approved and scheduled by the instructors. Unless permission is given otherwise, all project horses can only be handled or ridden when there are EVEC staff at the stable.** This is for insurance reasons.

Participant must:

- ❖ be a WORKING STUDENT with a set schedule
- ❖ have a weekly meeting with the trainer AND be able to follow our training methods and programs
- ❖ be able to record the proper documentation
- ❖ be able to retrieve, groom, tack and untack and properly care for the horse - unassisted
- ❖ be consistent in the amount of time required and the number of days needed to keep the horse on a schedule

Participants may be able to take their paid lessons on the project horse / pony. Although a participant doing Project Sessions may be able to join a group lesson, these are not counted as the participant's paid lessons.

Fee: \$100/month (as a minimum donation) per month. Regular donations on a committed basis are needed to help take care of this animal. Donations can be made monetarily or as feed / hay purchases.

This club is for children and teens and is open to the public. The cost to attend an EQUI-VENTURE Corner Corral meeting is only \$10 for up to 2 hours of fun with horses! For children and teens that are Active EVEC students, their cost is only \$5. Please note that the cost of lesson materials and arts & crafts supplies are an additional donation. These fees are posted ahead of time in our newsletter, on our website and / or the sign-up sheets. There will also be an additional fee of \$5 to cover insurance costs when there is a mounted lesson. **Financial assistance may be available. Reservations and fees are due the Saturday before the meeting date.**

PARENT'S GROUP

\$40 divided by the number of participants **or \$8 per parent** if less than 5 participants. **Fees are due the Saturday before the meeting date.**

MOUNTED CLINICS

EQUESTRIAN TEAMS

DRILL TEAM

- Rider is responsible for any demonstration related costs including but not limited to: equipment, uniform, transportation, insurance fees, entry fees, etc.
- Must ride two other times per week.
- \$10 per rider for practice session. \$5 if rider his / her uses own or leased horse / pony.
- **Session fees are due the Saturday before the practice date.**

SHOW TEAM

This activity is for a registered Show Team member. **A regular or active student that attends a show is not considered a Show Team member.** A Show Team member has paid a membership to belong to the team and stays active with the team: attends meetings, takes appropriate lessons or clinics, attends team activities, etc. A team member must volunteer at the stable and / or help with lessons on a regular schedule.

- **The cost for a Show Team lesson day is \$40 per time slot (with in-stable instructors). This cost is divided by the number of members in that time slot. (5 riders maximum)**
- **School Horse Rental if needed for each one hour session:** discounted to \$10
- **Tack Rental if needed:** \$5 and up
- **Lesson day fees are due the Saturday before the lesson date.**

Other fees and obligations include but, are not limited to:

- Registration fee for team
- Insurance fee
- Responsible for all show & traveling expenses
- Must take 2 regular lessons each week (Active Student Status)
- Must attend & pay for applicable schooling sessions & clinics
- Must be at show team lesson day or at an Equestrian Club lesson day
- Must attend club meetings (once a month) & pay dues
- Must be able to prepare for, attend, and pay all expenses to show

EVEC HORSE/PONY RENTAL

(If not full leasing or half leasing the EVEC horse/pony)

In-Stable Show (Horse / pony may be shared): \$5 per class with \$20 minimum or \$15 per each Event Phase

Away Show (Horse / pony may be shared): \$10 (if we provide coaching) per class with \$40 minimum **OR**
\$15 (if we do not coach) per class with \$60 minimum

Horse Trial, Combined Test or Event as well as any other activity where the number of riders are limited:
\$75 and up per day

HORSE & RIDER PREP

Trainer, coach, instructor and/or an assistant warms up the horse and/or frames up the horse, if permitted, while rider prepares for classes: \$20

SET UP TACKROOM or TRAILER SITE

For Away Shows \$25 divided among clients

RIDER FEE

Coach, trainer, instructor and/or an assistant riding your horse in classes: \$10 per class

ADDITIONAL SHOW FEES

Any other fees not listed (hotel fees, setup materials etc.) are to be divided equally among all clients. All clients entered in a show as of the entry deadline are responsible for all non-negotiable fees for that show (stall, tack stall, hotel fees, etc.)

GROOMING AT SHOWS

\$75/day for full care per client OR \$40/day for partial care per client PLUS tips.

Grooms may be assigned to more than one client. If a client wants his/her own personal groom, arrangements must be made in advance. (This does not include any show prep OR for help back at the stable after the show as listed in our Additional Services). Grooms are to be treated with respect and are there to help you; not to do everything for you!

Partial care at the show includes:

- Packing all equipment required at the show: trunks, hay, grain, tack, etc.
- Feeding and watering
- Mucking
- Unwrapping
- Medications
- **Helping** riders with the other responsibilities that include but are not limited to: washing, unbraiding, wrapping, picking horse's feet, grazing, hand-walking, lunging, hacking, poulticing, staying at trailer, etc.

Full care at the show includes:

- Everything listed under partial care.
- Grooming
- Bathing
- Tacking and untacking
- Tack cleaning at show
- Unbraiding
- Poulticing
- Rub downs
- Wrapping legs
- Transfers the responsibility from rider to EVEC and their staff.
- **NOTE:** This service is offered only to those who are not present to be involved themselves. It is our belief that we are creating educated, responsible and experienced horsemen when they are involved in both the riding and care of their animals.

NOTE: Fees will vary depending on distance, time, and fuel costs and may change at any time due to economic reasons.

- **Total fuel cost to be divided** by number of horses being hauled **PLUS \$.60 per mile per horse both directions**, empty or loaded.
- A **\$35 Hook Up Fee per horse** will be added to the above.
(Covers vehicle insurance, normal wear & tear on trailer & vehicle)
- There is always a **minimum charge of \$50**.
- This **fee does not include the driver's fee** for waiting at a show, clinic, event, etc.
- Call for reservation and quote.

EVEC SHOW TEAM, PONY CLUB and 4-H MEMBER TRANSPORTATION

NOTE: Fees will vary depending on distance, time, and fuel costs and may change at any time due to economic reasons.

- **Total fuel cost to be divided** by number of horses being hauled **PLUS \$.60 per mile per horse both directions**, empty or loaded.
- The **Hook-Up Fee** is reduced to **\$15 per horse**.
(Covers vehicle insurance, normal wear & tear on trailer & vehicle)
- There is **no minimum charge**.
- This **fee does not include the driver's fee** for waiting at a show, clinic, event, etc.

DRIVER FEES

For the driver of trailer to wait at location **divided** equally among all clients
\$8 per hour & meals OR a maximum of \$60 per day

HORSE TRANSPORTATION

TRAILERING

NOTE: Fees will vary depending on distance, time, and fuel costs and may change at any time due to economic reasons.

- **Total fuel cost to be divided** by number of horses being hauled **PLUS \$.75 per mile per horse both directions**, empty or loaded.
- A **\$50 Hook Up Fee** will be added to the above.
(Covers vehicle insurance, normal wear & tear on trailer & vehicle)
- There is always a **minimum charge of \$75**.
- This **fee does not include the driver's fee** (if applicable) for waiting at a show, clinic, event, etc.
- Call for reservation and quote.

DRIVER FEES

For the driver of trailer to wait at location **divided** equally among all clients
\$8 per hour & meals

SPONSORSHIPS

A sponsorship is for those that can provide regular weekly or monthly donations for a minimum of 3 months. During the term of the sponsorship; you will receive the horse's story, a picture of the horse when it arrives at the rescue, a monthly photo update, visits with the horse at the rescue (by appointment only), and an adoption update when a permanent adopter is found. Although some horses may be adoptable immediately; the typical rehabilitation period is six to 12 months. As a monthly sponsor; you have first option to complete an adoption application for a horse once rehabilitated, or to continue sponsorship for monthly care.

Donors will be acknowledged on the Home page and Facebook page for EVEC. Sponsors will also be acknowledged on those webpages as well as on the webpage for the sponsored horse and in our newsletters and ezines.

OUR SPONSORSHIP PROGRAMS

Sponsors allow us to continue our program and rescue more horses. Our most important sponsorships are those that support our horses directly and enable us to keep them healthy and safe. The best way you can help is to adopt a horse, since our main goal is to find permanent, loving homes for all of our rescued horses. However, if you are unable to adopt a horse; you can still help a horse by sponsoring the costs for it's care until a permanent home is found.

RESCUE HORSE CARE PROGRAM (\$200 / month): Our **most important sponsorship program** is our monthly Horse Care Program. Averaged over the course of a year; it costs our rescue approximately \$200 per month for basic care for a horse. This includes hay, feed/supplements, regular worming (every eight weeks), hoof trimming (every eight weeks), dental care, and vaccines.

During the initial month of the sponsorship; you will receive the horse's story and a picture of the horse when it first arrived at our rescue, a current photo of the horse during the subsequent month(s) sponsored, visits with the horse at our rescue (by appointment only), and a first option to continue as a sponsor for monthly care until adopted, and an adoption update when a permanent adopter is found.

FEED-A-RESCUE HORSE PROGRAM (\$150 / month): Probably our **most needed sponsorship program** is our monthly Feed-A-Horse Program. Our feed costs are our biggest expense. As mentioned before, our sponsors allow us to rescue more horses, and we hope you'll commit to sponsorship until your horse is adopted. Averaged over the course of a year, it costs the rescue at least \$150 per month just to feed each horse. This includes hay and senior supplemental feed. This sponsorship will put a large dent in the feed costs for each horse; and we strive to secure a sponsor for each horse we accept into our program

As a feed sponsor, during each month of the sponsorship; you will be recognized on the horse's webpage as the sponsor of the horse, and you will be able to visit with the horse at the rescue (by appointment only). You will have first option to continue sponsorship of your sponsored horse until adopted, and you will receive an adoption update when a permanent adopter is found.

EQUI-PROJECT PROGRAM (\$ 100 minimum / month): Please refer to the end of the Leasing Section of this document about this unique Hands-On sponsorship.

HELP SUPPORT YOUR FAVORITE SCHOOL HORSE FOR A MONTH (\$100 / month): Perhaps you have a favorite school horse and you are willing to help take care of his / her expenses. This in turn will help us save money on this well deserved horse and apply it to the rescue efforts.

SAVE A HORSE (\$800): Our Save A Horse program gives you the privilege of rescuing a horse from the feedlot. Although the “ransom” (or meat value) is typically donated by others; this sponsorship allows a horse to come EVEC and helps to provide three months of initial and basic care costs at the rescue. Basic care includes feeding twice a day, worming and hoof trimming every eight weeks, vaccines, dental care, and basic handling. This does not include veterinary care for any extraordinary injuries or illness that may be needed.

GIFT FOR A HORSE (\$ ANY): When you have a gift to give, give the gift of life. Make a donation (in any amount) on behalf of a horse-loving friend or family member. You will receive an electronic “gift letter” with a photo of an EVEC horse, acknowledging your gift on behalf of your recipient.
